Expectations:

As an Education staff, under the supervision of the Daycare Director, as well as in accordance with the program statement of the centre, the philosophy and policies of Evergreen Heights Christian Fellowship, and in compliance with the Childcare and Early Years Act, you are expected to:

- Effectively foster children exploration, play and inquiry
- Be responsible for constant supervision, safety, and well-being of children
- Recognizes and responds to the needs of each child using developmentally appropriate teaching and child behaviour management techniques
- Communicates effectively with supervisor, co-workers, parts, and other team members
- Observes and records relevant information for each child as per centre practices
- Participate as a conscientious team member in caring for the children and in the overall operation of the program and centre daily
- Implements four foundations of how does learning happen through curriculum planning
- Understands child development and consistently assesses child's development, advocating when referrals are necessary
- Shares responsibility for maintaining play environments and storage areas
- Completes additional tasks such as laundry, cleaning, and staff coverage as required.
